Scaling Up for the Future: First Two Replacement Cranes Arriving at GCT Deltaport as Part of \$170M Modernization Project

DELTA, B.C. – Global Container Terminals (GCT) is preparing to welcome the first two of six replacement ship-to-shore (STS) cranes to GCT Deltaport. These new state-of-the-art Megamax cranes mark a major milestone in the \$170 million project to enhance terminal operations and strengthen Canada's Pacific Gateway.

What:

- Arrival of two new Megamax Capable STS cranes at GCT Deltaport; some of the largest and most advanced STS cranes in North America.
- Part of the GCT Deltaport STS Crane Replacement Project (2025–2027), enhancing infrastructure with modern, reliable equipment.
- Upon project completion, GCT Deltaport's fleet will include eight Megamax cranes and four Super Post-Panamax cranes.

Benefits:

- Significant investment in terminal equipment to enhance safety, modernization, reliability and efficiency.
- Greater flexibility across all berths to effectively serve the largest vessels on the trade lane and meet the shifting demands of global trade.
- This underscores GCT's commitment to effective, responsible technology. The new cranes will utilize real-time data to boost capabilities at GCT Deltaport.
- With our proven track record in strategic investment and project delivery, we will continue to ensure optimal service and maintain a competitive edge at Canada's largest marine container terminal.

Offloading and Commissioning:

- The heavy load carrier vessel will be offloading two new STS cranes on the north side of Berth 3.
- Operations across all three berths are ongoing, with all current STS cranes in service, including 11 and 12,
- The commissioning of two new STS cranes occurs in a small work zone that does not impact operations.
- Truck gate and yard operations are ongoing with no impact.
- Rail operations are ongoing with no impact.
- GCT started work on this project in 2024. All project work is proactively managed to have no impact on ongoing operations across all three berths.

When:

- Estimated crane arrival: April 19, 2025
- Offloading period: Approximately 10 days
- Commissioning: Up to 3 months
