



GCT Deltaport Ship-to-Shore (STS) Crane Replacement Project Update

February 12th, 2026: We're excited to share another project update for the STS Crane Replacement Project.

With the first two of our six new cranes successfully on-site and two older units decommissioned in January, we are now preparing for the arrival of our next two state-of-the-art STS cranes. This \$170 million investment in modern, efficient equipment will enhance safety, improve operations, and maintain the competitiveness of Canada's Pacific Gateway.

Additional deliveries, for a total of six cranes, will continue through 2027. The process will look similar to when we received new cranes last April. Designed to blend with our existing equipment, these new STS cranes are electric-powered, feature regenerative drives to reduce energy use, and include high-efficiency LED lighting to minimize glare.

What to Expect:

- **Estimated Arrival of New Cranes:** February 19th, 2026
- **Transport:** The cranes will be transported pre-assembled by a specialized vessel and safely offloaded over approximately 10 days.
- **Commissioning:** Further on-site commissioning will take place for up to three months within the standard operating schedule.
- **Location:** GCT Deltaport, 2 Roberts Bank Way, Tsawwassen, BC
- **Impacts:** No significant impact on sound or lighting in the surrounding community is expected. No impact on terminal operations including vessel, rail and gate schedules.
