

Verification Statement

Introduction

Global Container Terminals Inc. (the “Responsible Party”) engaged Brightspot Climate Inc. (Brightspot Climate) to verify their corporate greenhouse gas (GHG) inventory for their fiscal year 2025.

The Responsible Party’s “GHG Statement” is comprised of the GHG corporate inventory report prepared by Global Container Terminals found on the Nasdaq Metrio platform as of March 12, 2026, and other supporting documentation. The GHG Statement covers the reporting period, January 1, 2025 – December 31, 2025, and states a total GHG emissions inventory over this period, as follows:

The GHG Statement is based on historical GHG information.



The Responsible Party is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the GHG statement in accordance with the criteria. Our responsibility as the verifier is to express an opinion on the GHG statement based on the verification.

Scope

We completed our review in accordance with the ISO 14064 Part 3: *Greenhouse Gases: Specification with Guidance for the Verification and Validation of Greenhouse Gas Statements* (ISO, 2019). As such, we planned and performed our work to provide positive, but not absolute assurance with respect to the GHG Assertion. The inventory was verified at a reasonable level of assurance.

The verification procedures that were performed through the course of the verification were developed based on the results of a risk assessment that was completed during the verification planning stage. These verification procedures are described in the Verification Plan. Certain verification procedures included data sampling.

Conclusion

Ten unresolved immaterial discrepancies remain in the GHG Statement and are detailed in the Verification Report. The aggregate of the immaterial discrepancies does not breach the materiality threshold.

As it currently stands, based on our review, it is my opinion at a reasonable level of assurance that the GHG Statement is presented fairly, in all material respects, in accordance with the relevant criteria except for verification activities which have been identified as incomplete.
